### Cast:

- Small group of people—in clothing from world area other than your own—gathered around a battery-powered radio in one area of the platform
- Another small group gathered around a small television in another area
- Person with a portable radio and earphones centerstage
- Person with a cordless microphone ( D.J.)
- Person carrying a large envelope with “World Mission Broadcasting” written on it and cash sticking out of the envelope (obvious) and standing ready at the back of the room.

**D.J.:** *(walks over to one of the groups)* Can you hear me now?

*(All groups and person centerstage adjust the volume or sta-*

*tion on their media devices.)*

**D.J.:** *(walks over close to another group)* Can you hear me now?

*(Each of the groups checks equipment, but still do not respond.)*

**D.J.:** *(walks over close to the last group)* Can you hear me now?

*(Still no response from the groups of people. Person with envelope walks up to front and hands it to the D.J.)*

**D.J.:** Can you hear me now?

**All groups:** *(joyously)* **Yes!** Oh, yes!

**D.J.:** Give to World Mission Broadcast. Help “Reach the Unreached.”
