



# Saturday Night Insight

**Cast:** Kristen  
Heather  
Jenny

**Setting:** Saturday night sleepover

*(All three characters are teen girls, dressed in the latest “fads.” [Note: this can be adapted to include teenage boys. Change the setting to a party, and change the activity to playing video games.]*

*(Lights come up to reveal the girls at a sleepover. Music plays loudly in background—music may vary, according to the latest music popular with teens. The girls are lounging on and around the bed. They are all painting their toenails with bright-colored polish, and have cotton balls stuffed between their toes. They all “bop to the music,” swaying and rocking to the rhythm.)*

**Kristen:** *(Dramatically sings along with the music)*  
*[Note: use the latest song of a popular artist—Popular Artist #1]*

**Jenny:** Yeah, *[Popular Artist #1]* rocks! I got *[his/her]* new CD last week. *(Reaches over to turn music down a little)* Speaking of new CDs, did you hear that *[Popular Artist #2]* has a new CD coming out next week?

**Kristen:** That’s old news! I read about it in *Hits* magazine two months ago. I’ve been saving my allowance. My mom said she’d take me to *[local music store]* so I can be the **first** person to buy the CD when it comes out!

**Jenny:** Really? Oh, Kristen, my **best** friend in the whole world...Can I borrow the CD when you get it? Pleeaaaasssse? Can I?

**Kristen:** *(puts finger to chin and “thinks,” then gets an idea)* I **suppose** a deal could be worked out...if you let me borrow your new *[brand name]* jeans...

**Jenny:** Deal! *(They shake hands.)*

**Kristen:** *(turns to Heather)* What about you, Heather? Who is your favorite singer?

**Heather:** *(excitedly)* My favorite is *[Popular Artist #3]*!

**Jenny:** Yeah! *[He/She]* is **so cool!**

**Kristen:** Do you have the CD that has *[Popular Artist #3’s latest song]* on it?

**Heather:** *(matter of factly)* Nope. *(Jenny and Kristen gasp in shock.)*

**Kristen:** How do you stand it?

**Jenny:** Yeah! I would just **die** if I didn’t have *[Popular Artist #1’s]* CD!

**Heather:** I don’t really mind at all. See, my family has decided that for the next year, we will take turns giving the money we would normally spend on CDs to World Mission Broadcast. *[Current month]* is my month.

**Kristen:** World Mission Broadcast...isn’t that what *[local NMI president]* was talking about in the last mission service?
