

**Nazarene World Week of Prayer – February 28 – March 6, 2010**  
**Caribbean Region Requests**

1. Pray for the huge task of assisting more than 116,000 Haitian Nazarenes and their communities to recover from the devastating earthquake that struck the island in January. The Caribbean Regional Office through its arm of Nazarene Compassionate Ministries has responded since the first hour after the disaster and will continue to do so for many months. Pray for those working with Haitian Nazarenes to bring hope to the nation of Haiti.
  
2. Pray for the students studying for ministry at the Cuba Nazarene Seminary in Havana. With the Cuban nation primarily consisting of young people, pray that God will continue to assist our ministerial graduates to reach their communities with the message of God's love.
  
3. Pray for the Holiness Summits planned throughout the Caribbean in the coming year.
  
4. Pray for more than 1,500 Caribbean Nazarene churches that have committed to at least one-week of revival during the coming year. We believe that this will have a significant impact upon Caribbean Nazarenes as they seek spiritual revival in their local churches.
  
5. Pray for the Caribbean Nazarene Youth International Summer Regional Conference. Leaders throughout the region are helping find ways for Nazarene youth to raise funds to attend the Conference.
  
6. Pray for the travel of many Work & Witness teams that are coming to the Caribbean Region this year to help rebuild—especially in Haiti—dozens of churches destroyed in the recent earthquake. Pray for those organizing the teams. Logistics in Haiti, where so much has been destroyed, are extremely challenging; however, the teams are essential to the reconstruction.
  
7. Please pray for the extension ministry of each of the seminaries and colleges. These arms of the Nazarene educational institutions in the Caribbean consist primarily of ministerial education taking place in centers throughout the region and are conducted in a variety of languages. The extension centers are a major source of ministerial development.
  
8. Please pray for the Caribbean leaders elected to the Regional Advisory Committee who are facing specific regional leadership demands during the coming year.
  
9. Pray for the five Spanish districts in the Dominican Republic as they seek to multiply their ministries in expanding the church in this dynamic nation.

10. Pray for Nazarenes in Haiti who are attempting to reach the masses of displaced people as a result of the earthquake. The people have spiritual needs and trauma from the loss of family members and their dwellings. Therefore, our Haitian pastors and leaders need spiritual guidance and wisdom as they work with the displaced persons
